Automatic Tax Extensions

Dear GFC Client,

We recently contacted you about federal tax extensions granted by IRS for certain Vermont residents for victims of Hurricane Irene. There is new information we would like to share with you. Relief is now available for residents of nine Vermont counties. The nine counties are Addison, Bennington, Caledonia, Chittenden, Orange, Rutland, Washington, Windham, and Windsor. Taxpayers in these counties now have until October 31, 2011 to file their extended business returns originally due September 15, 2011 or their extended individual returns originally due October 17, 2011. In addition, third quarter estimates, which are due September 15, 2011 have also been extended to October 31, 2011.

We contacted Mary Peterson, Tax Commissioner for Vermont taxes. Mary told us Vermont will follow the federal relief so these extensions will apply for both federal and Vermont taxes.
